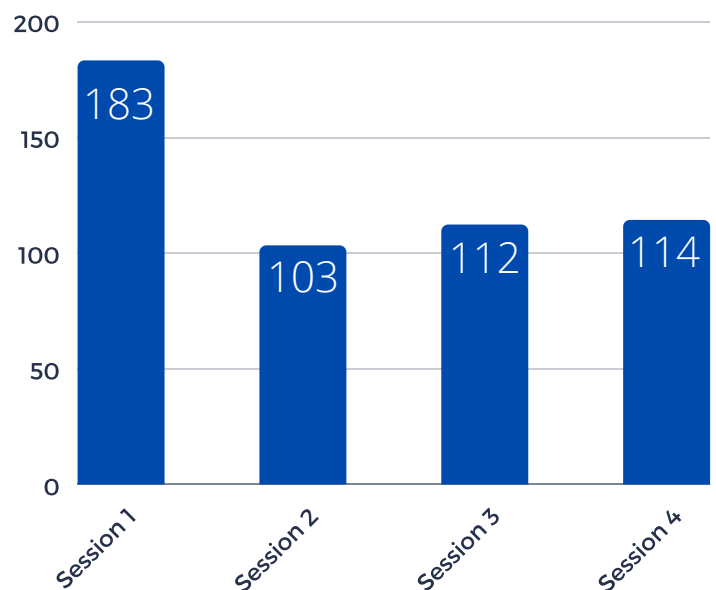

REGISTRATION STATISTICS

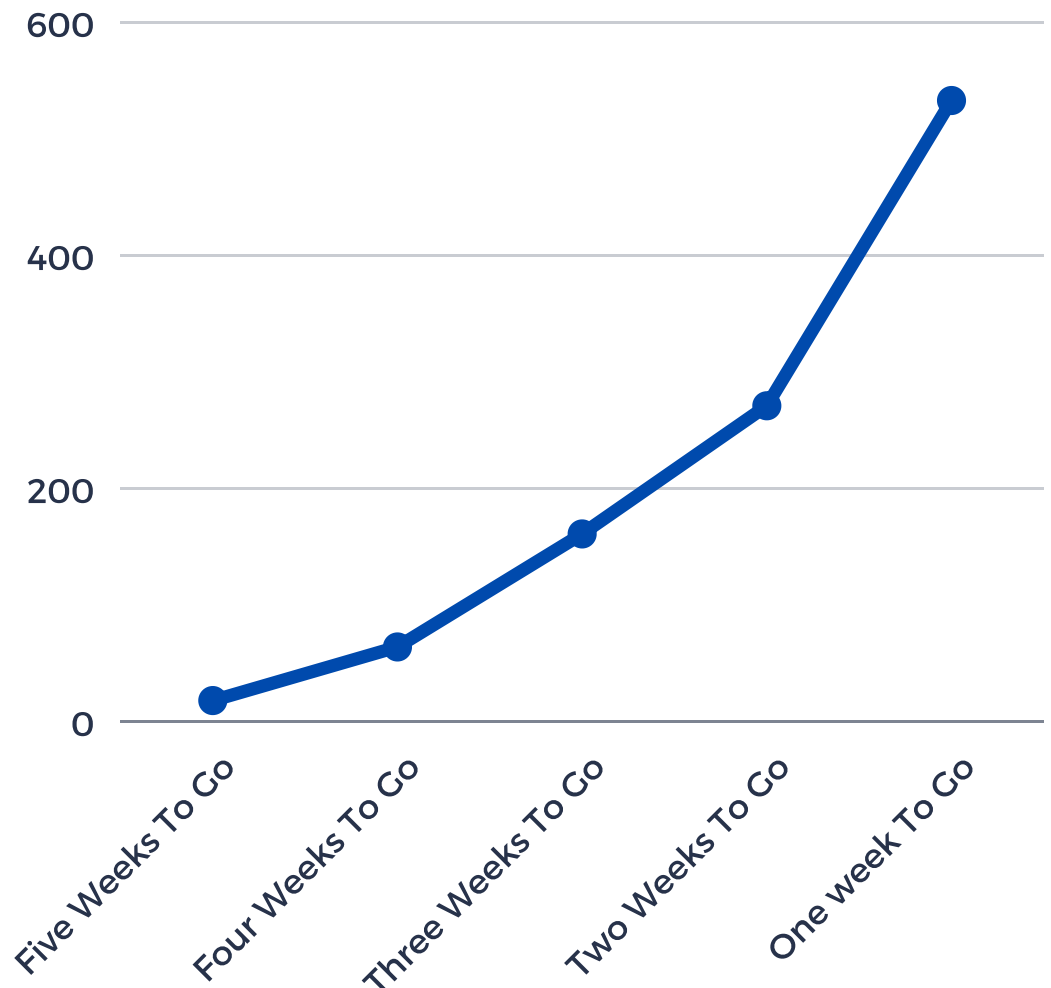

Registration Breakdown

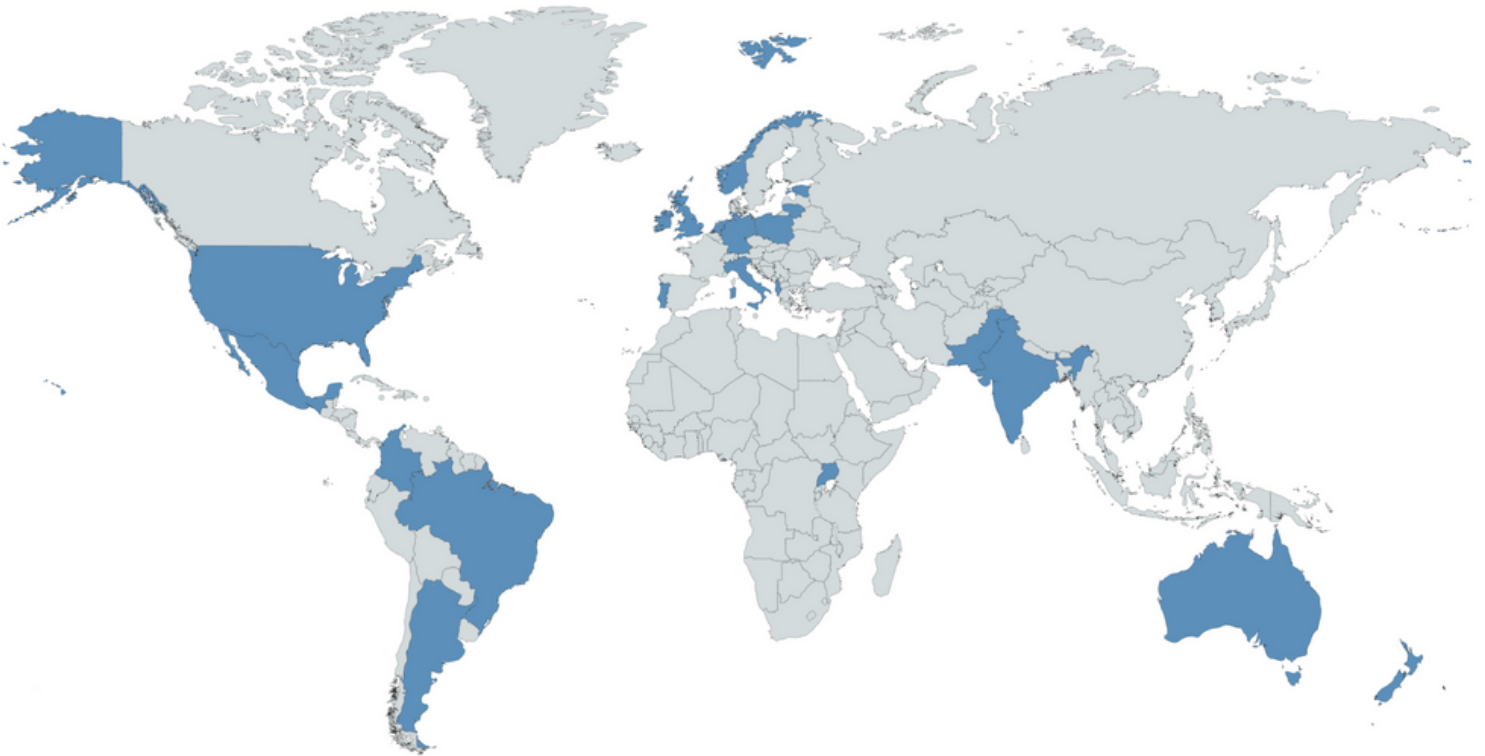

POSTER ABSTRACTS

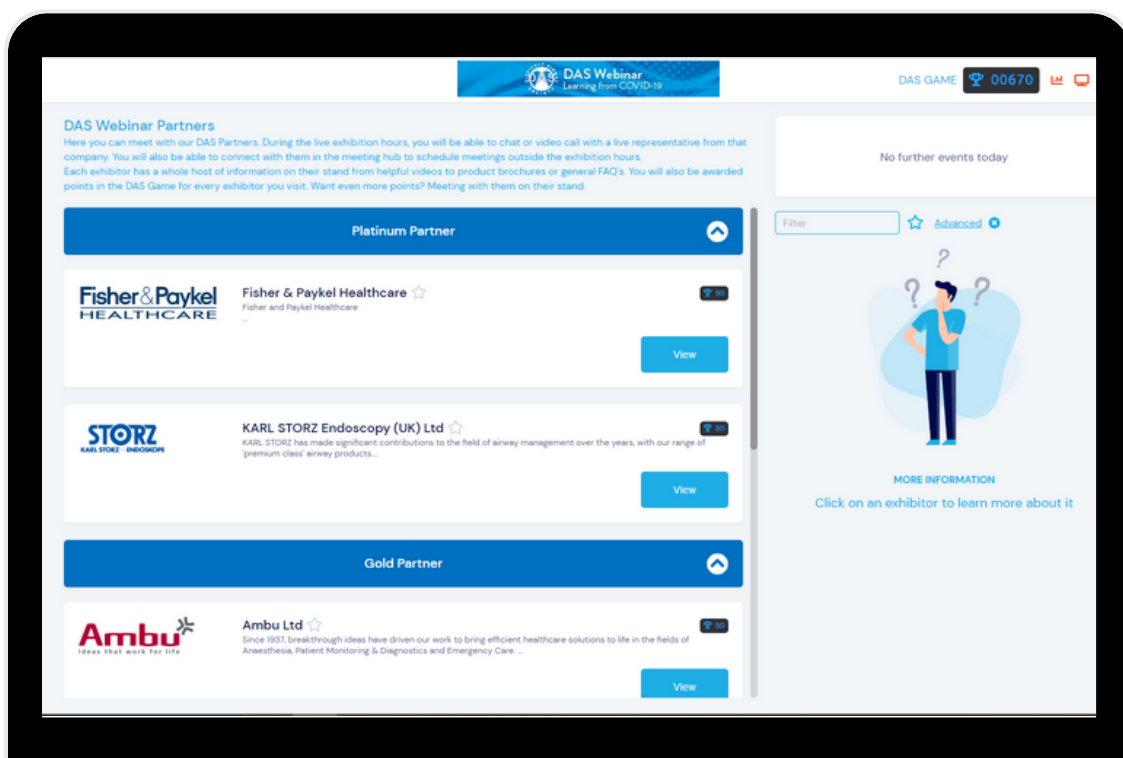

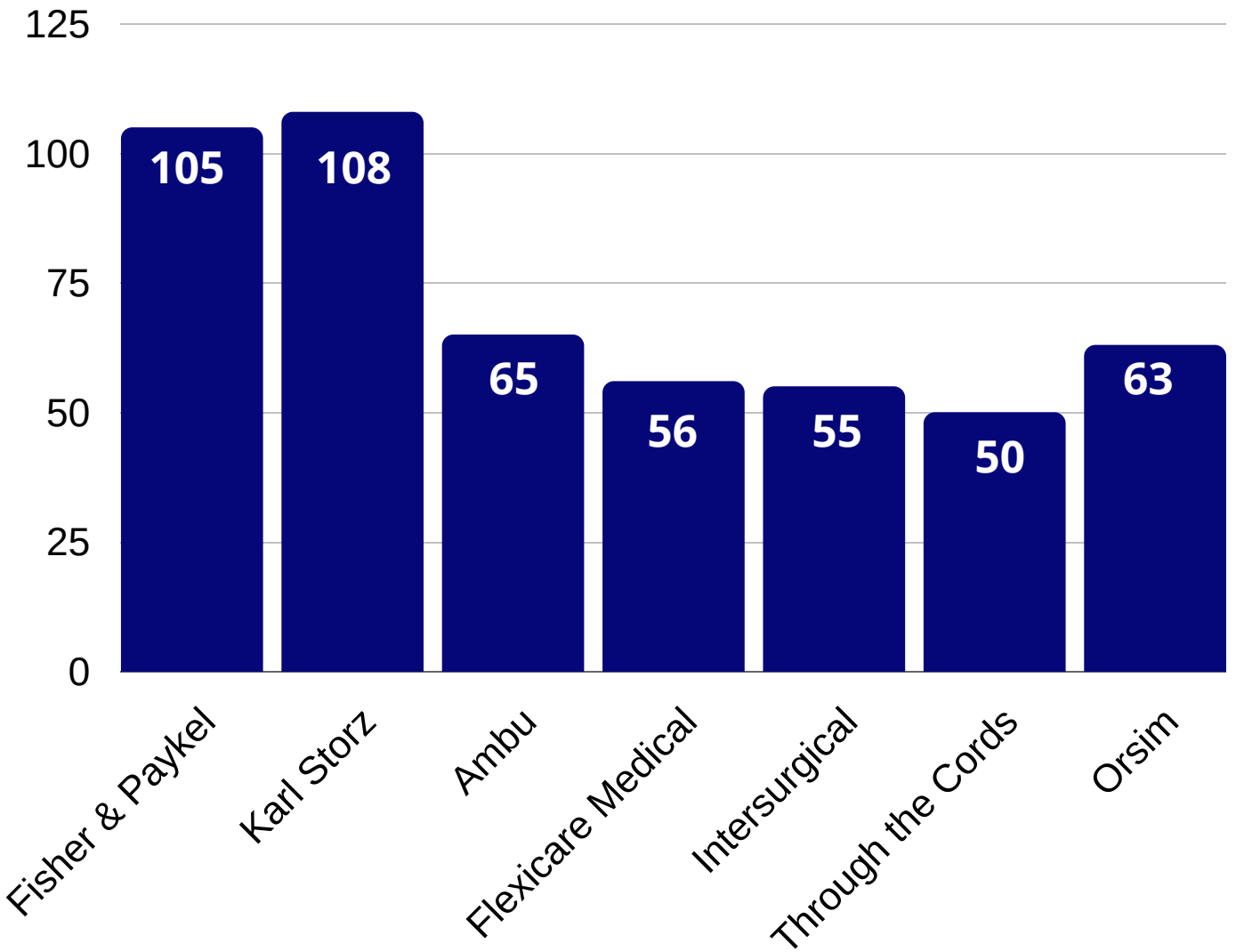

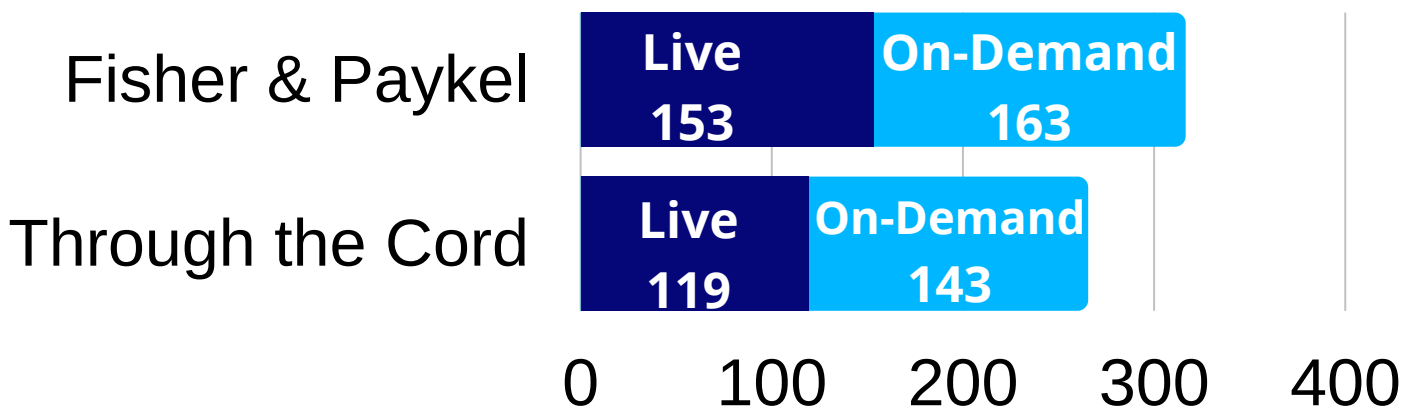
