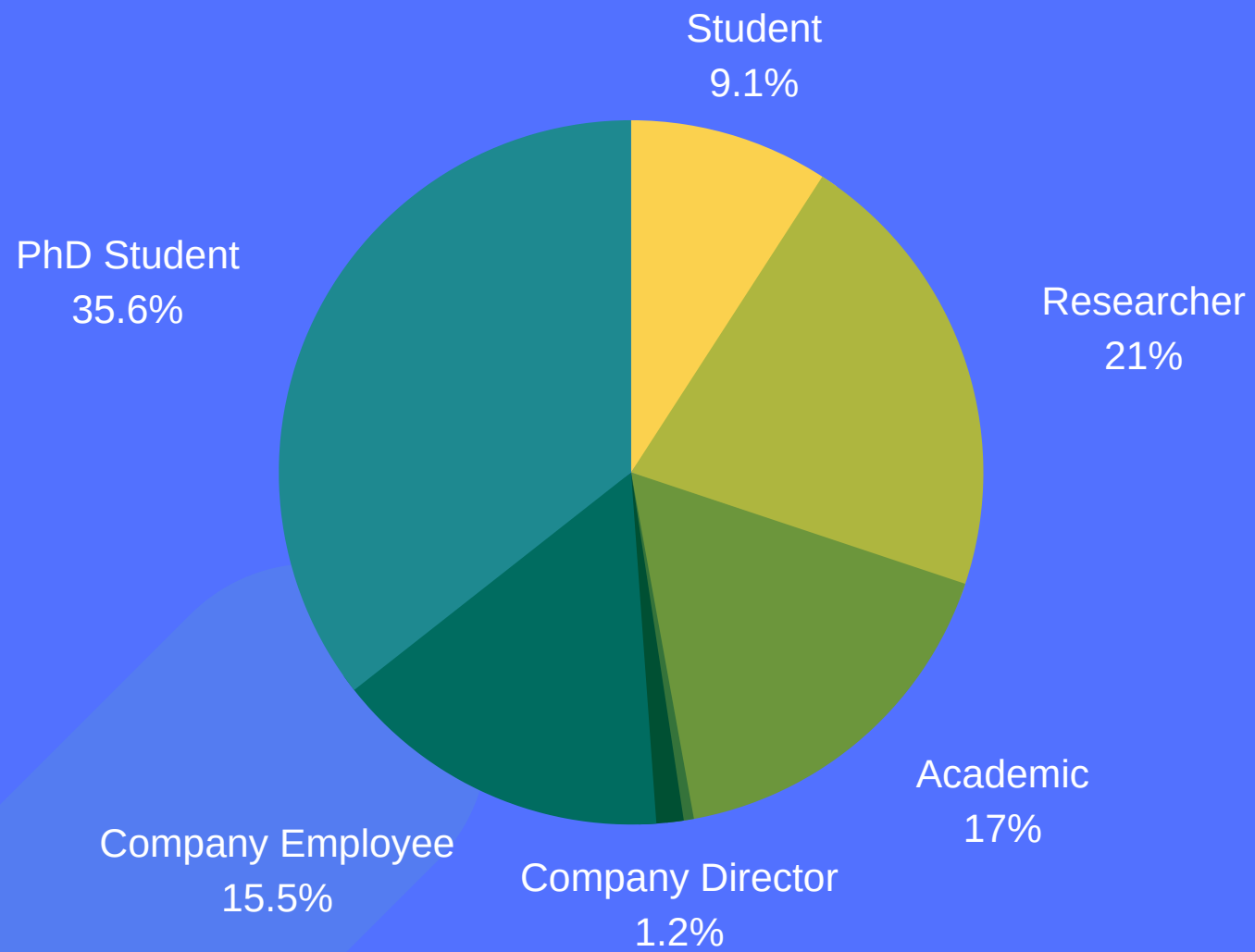

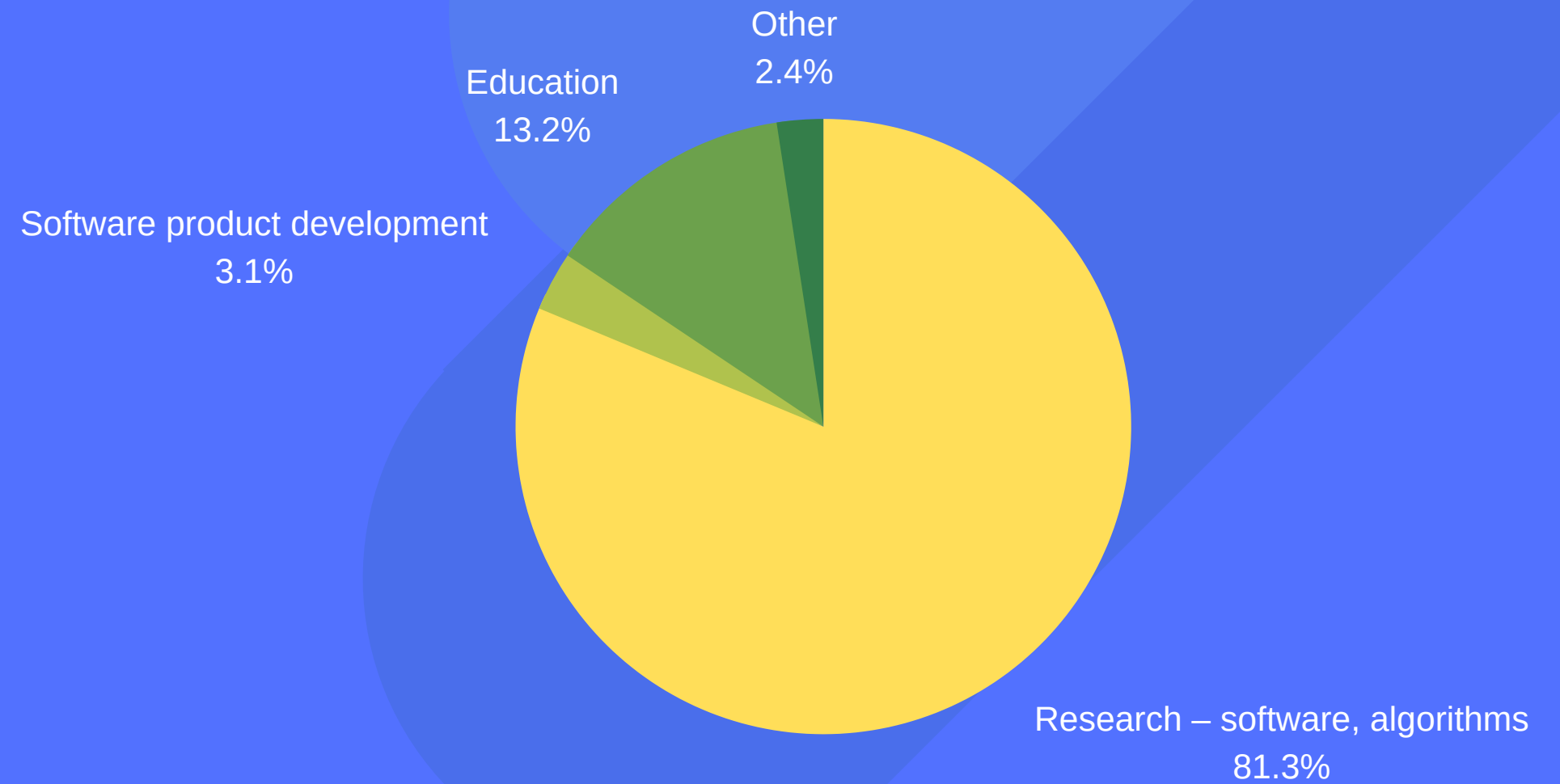

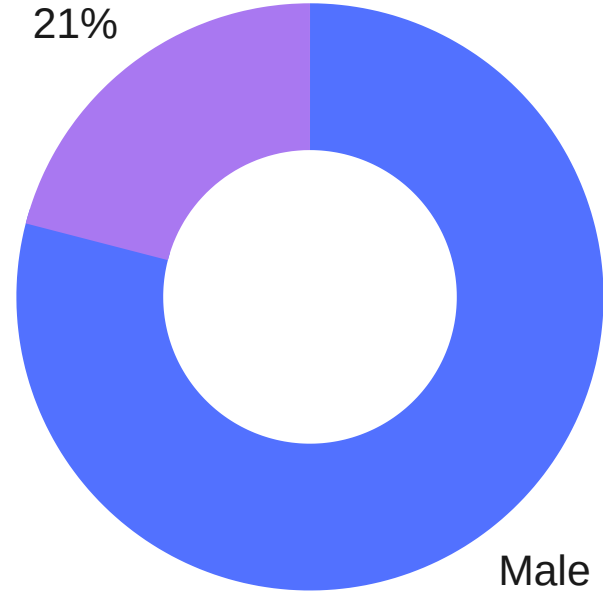


PROFESSIONAL STATUS



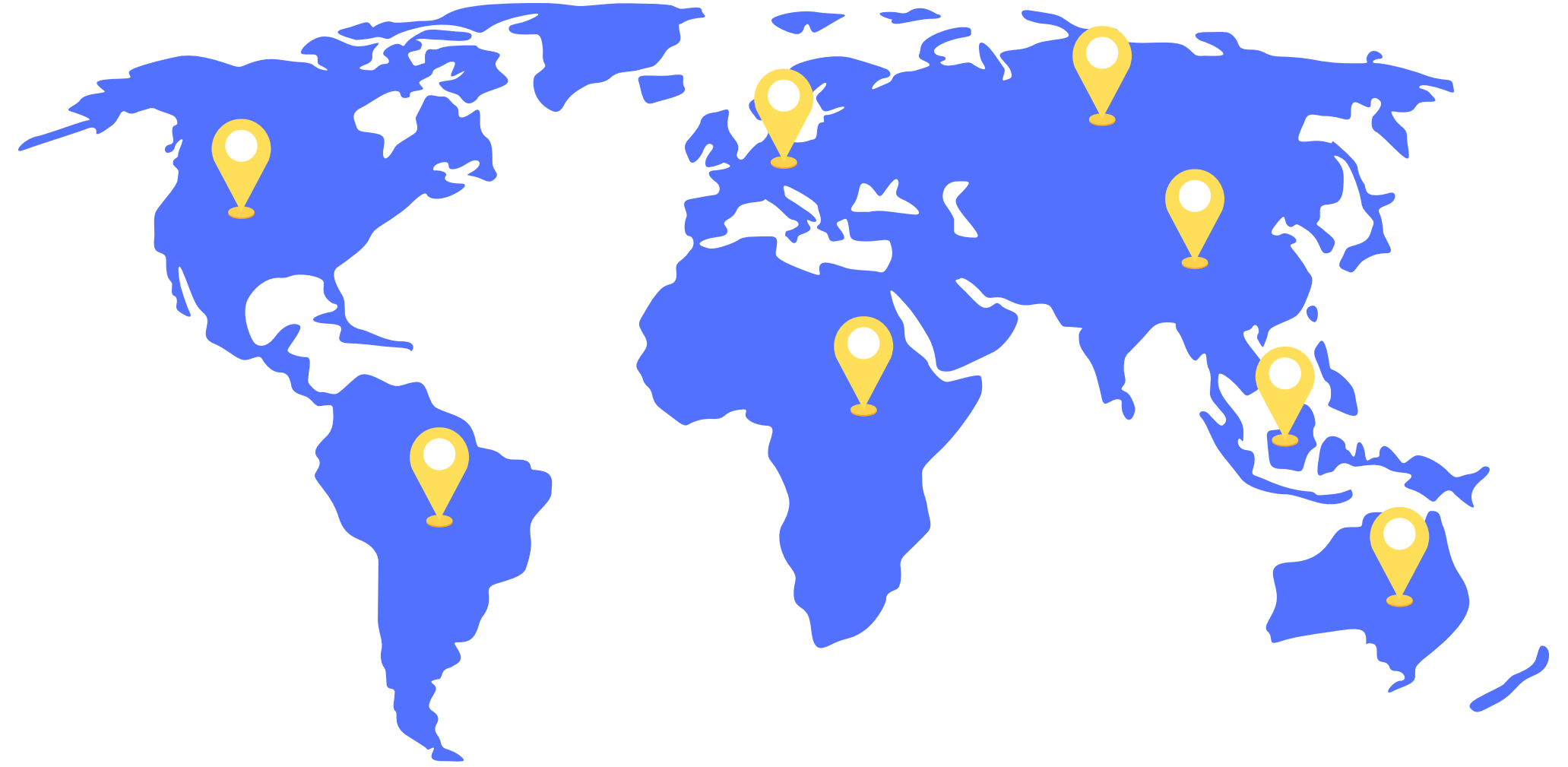

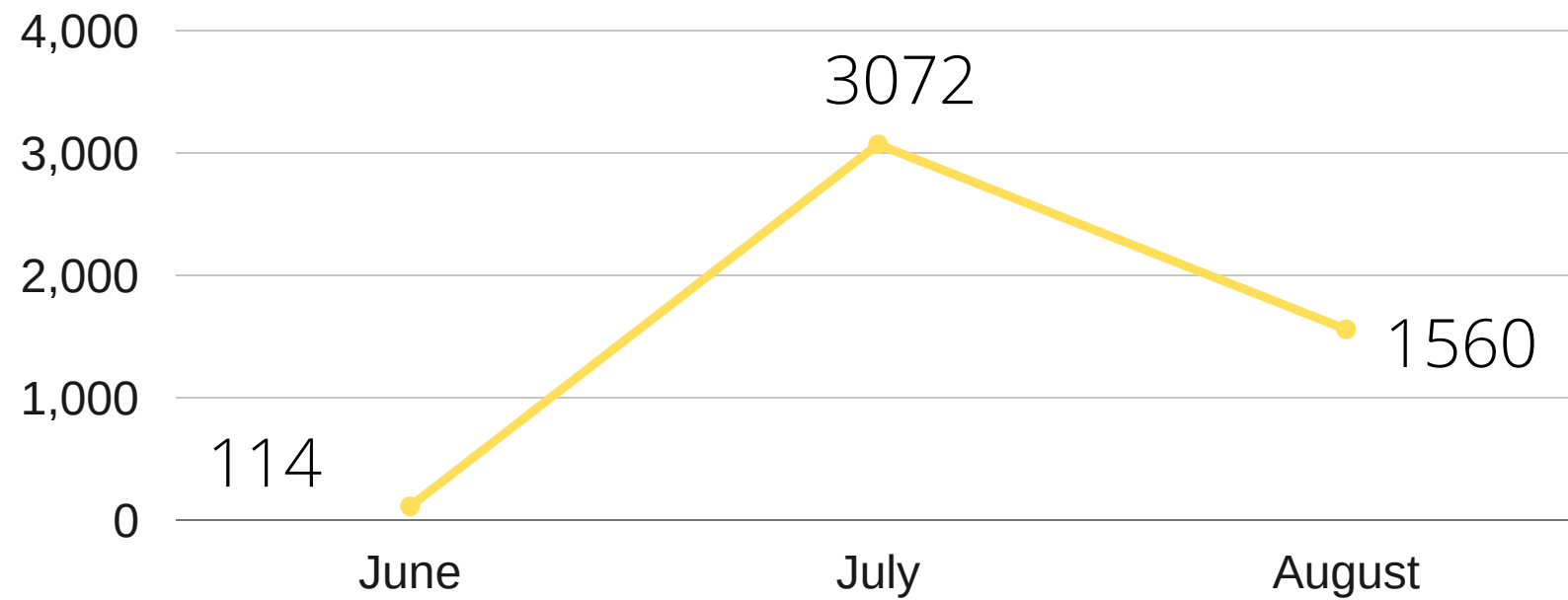

EXHIBITION HALL

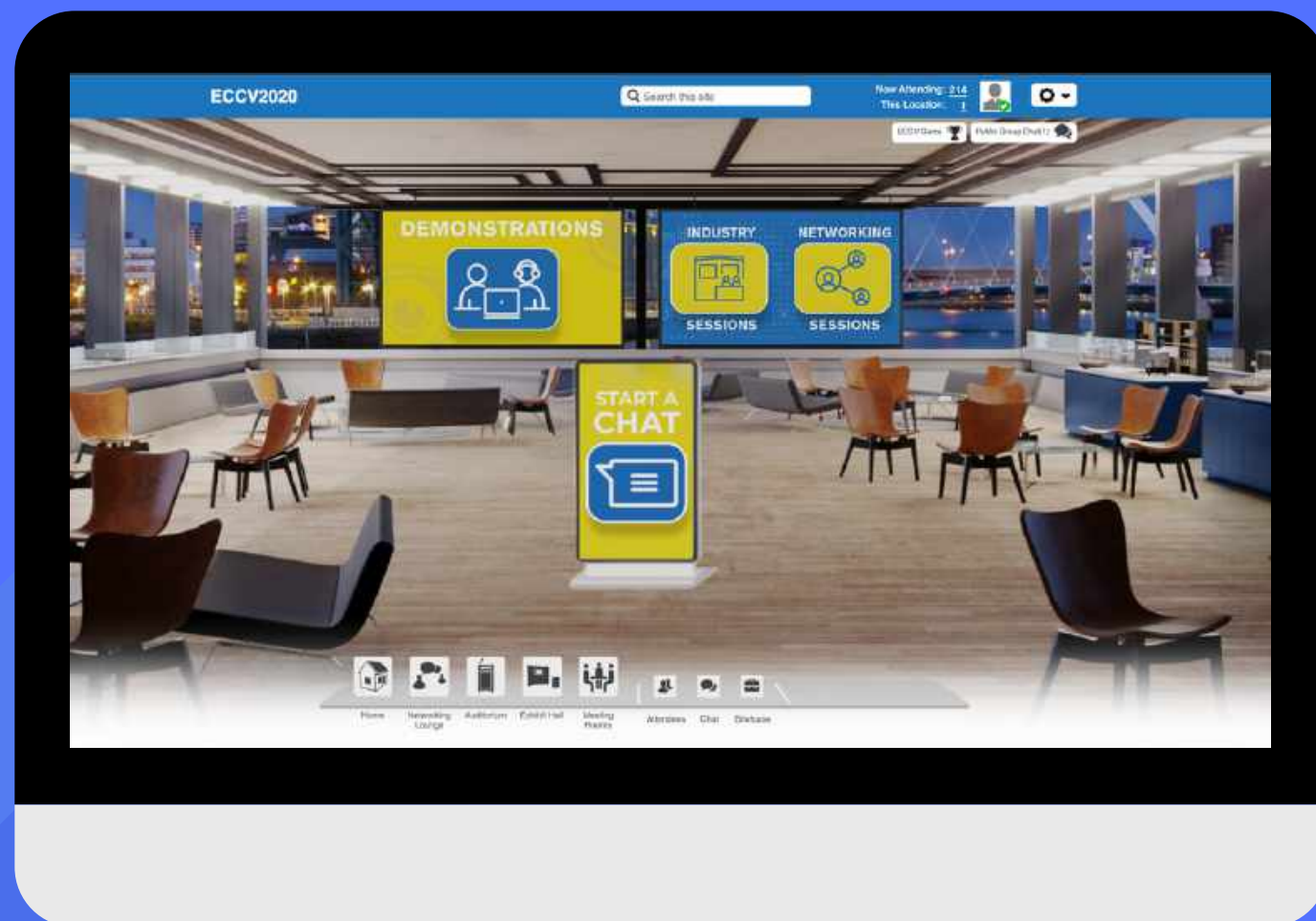
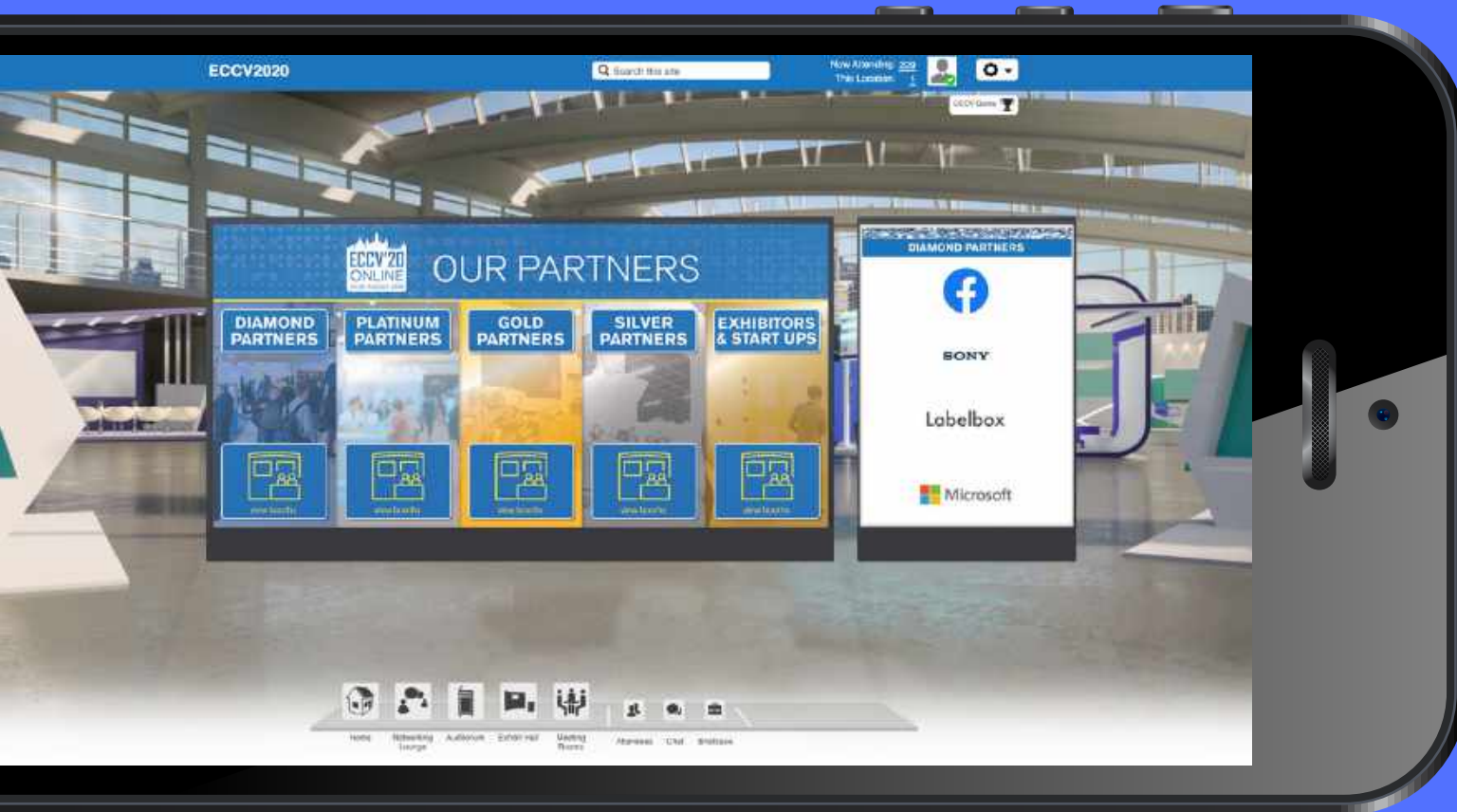
Our Exhibition hall was split into 5 sections for each of our levels of partnership. Delegates could visit each stand and arrange meetings with partners.

NETWORKING LOUNGE

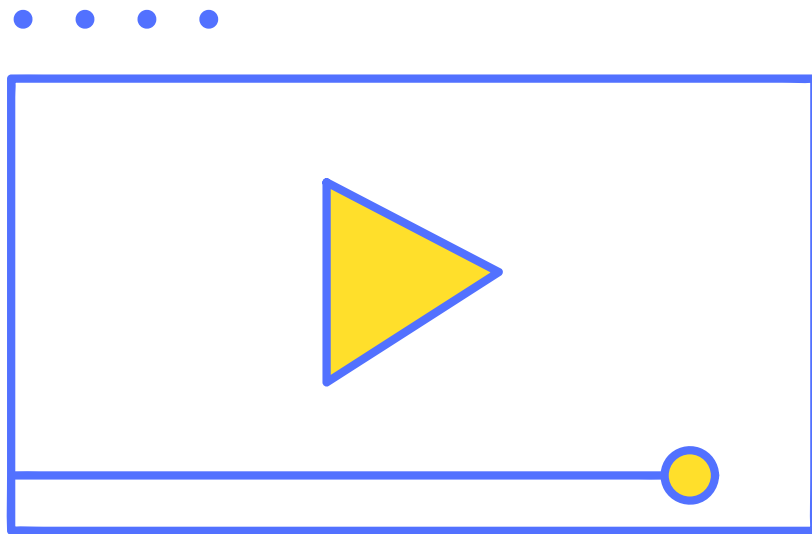
The networking lounge hosted all our Demonstrations and Industry Sessions. Delegates were also able to chat and join in yoga sessions in the area.

LIVE SESSIONS

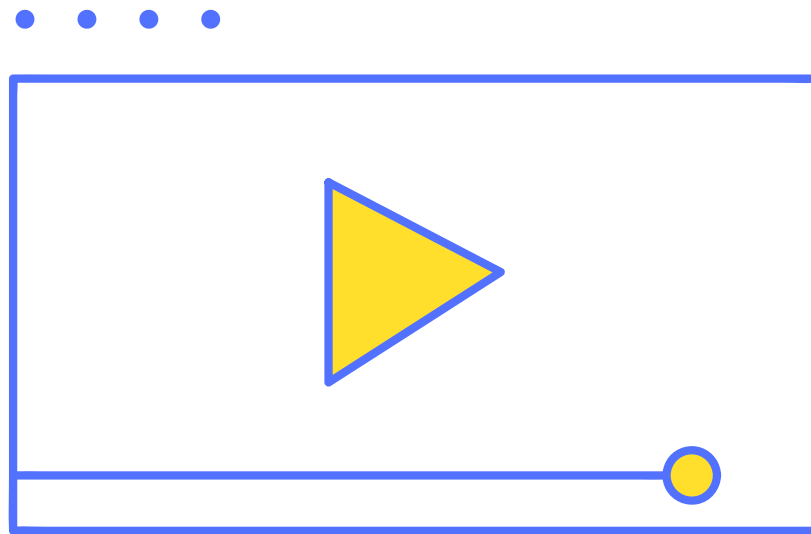
We had many different types of sessions taking place. In the main auditorium were our Oral and Spotlight sessions. While in a breakout room we hosted over 2000 poster sessions.



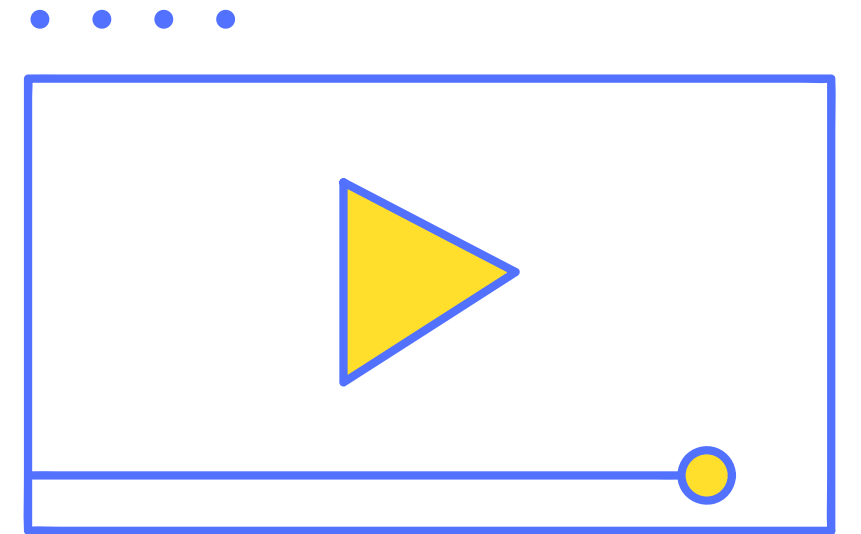

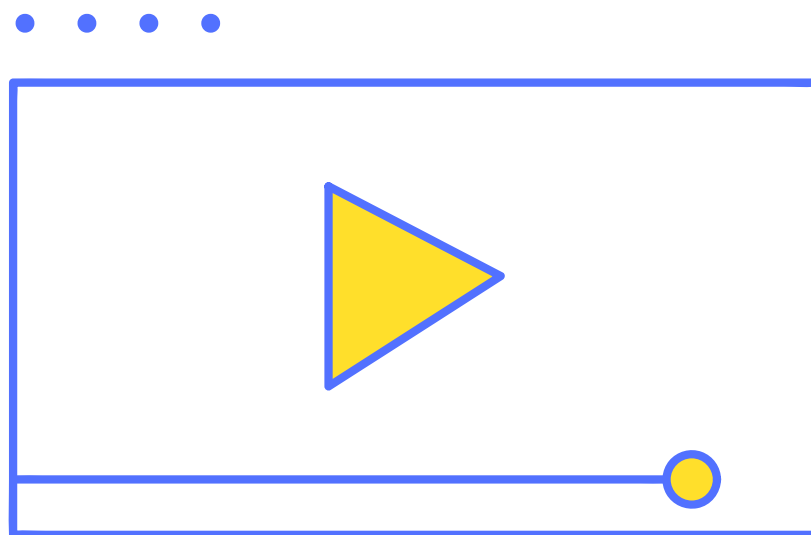

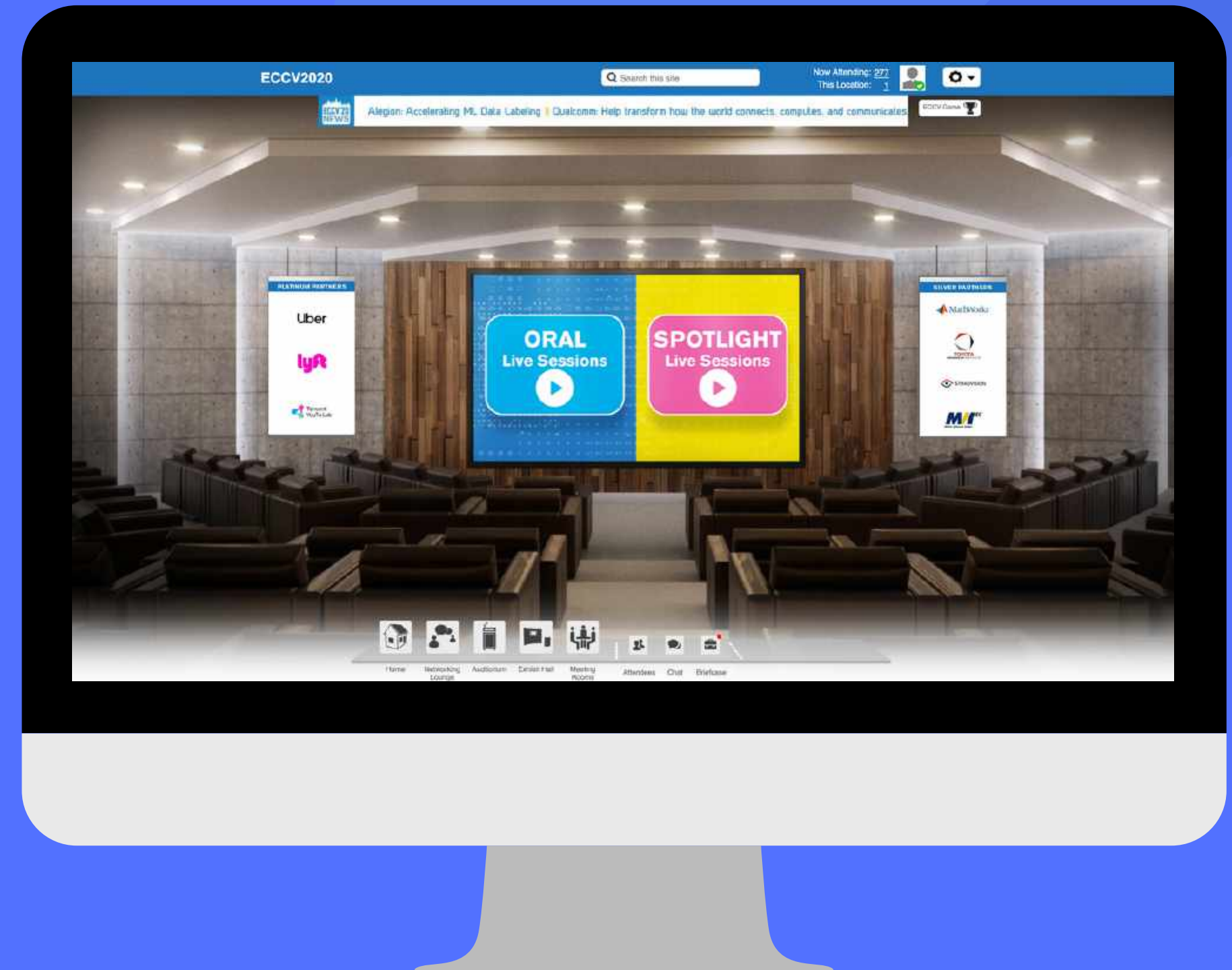

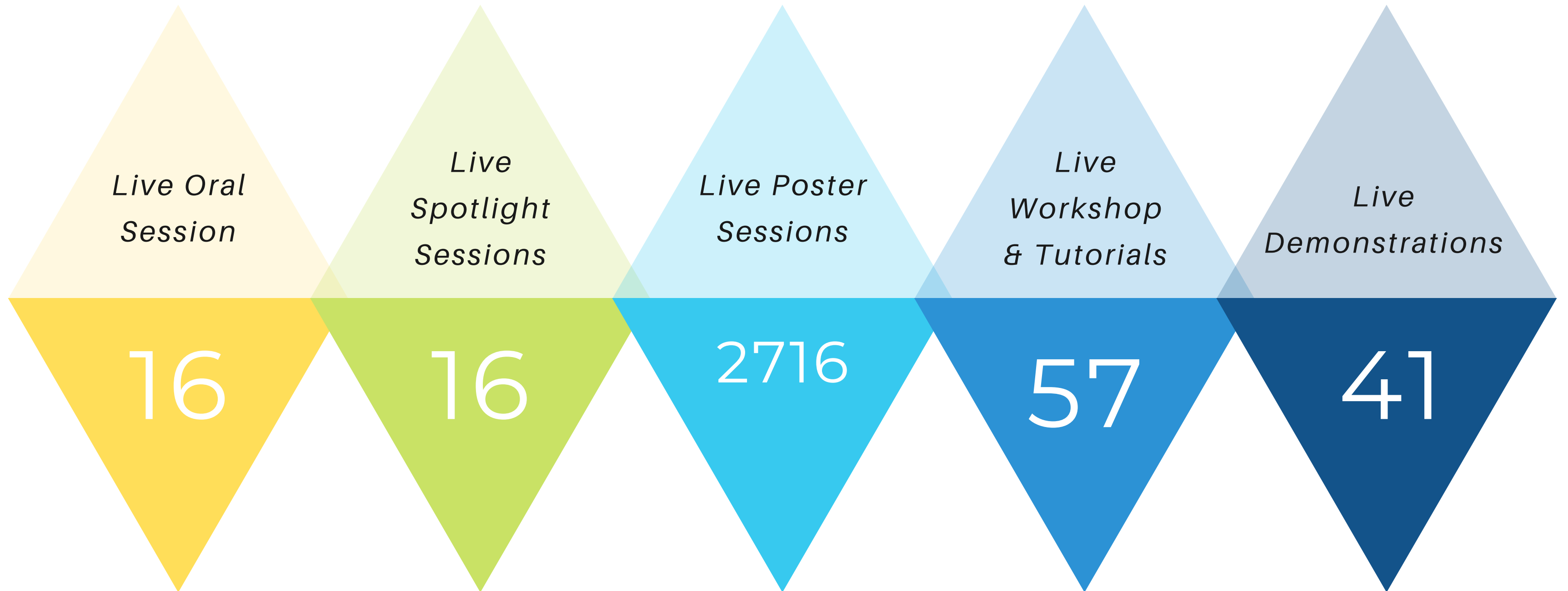

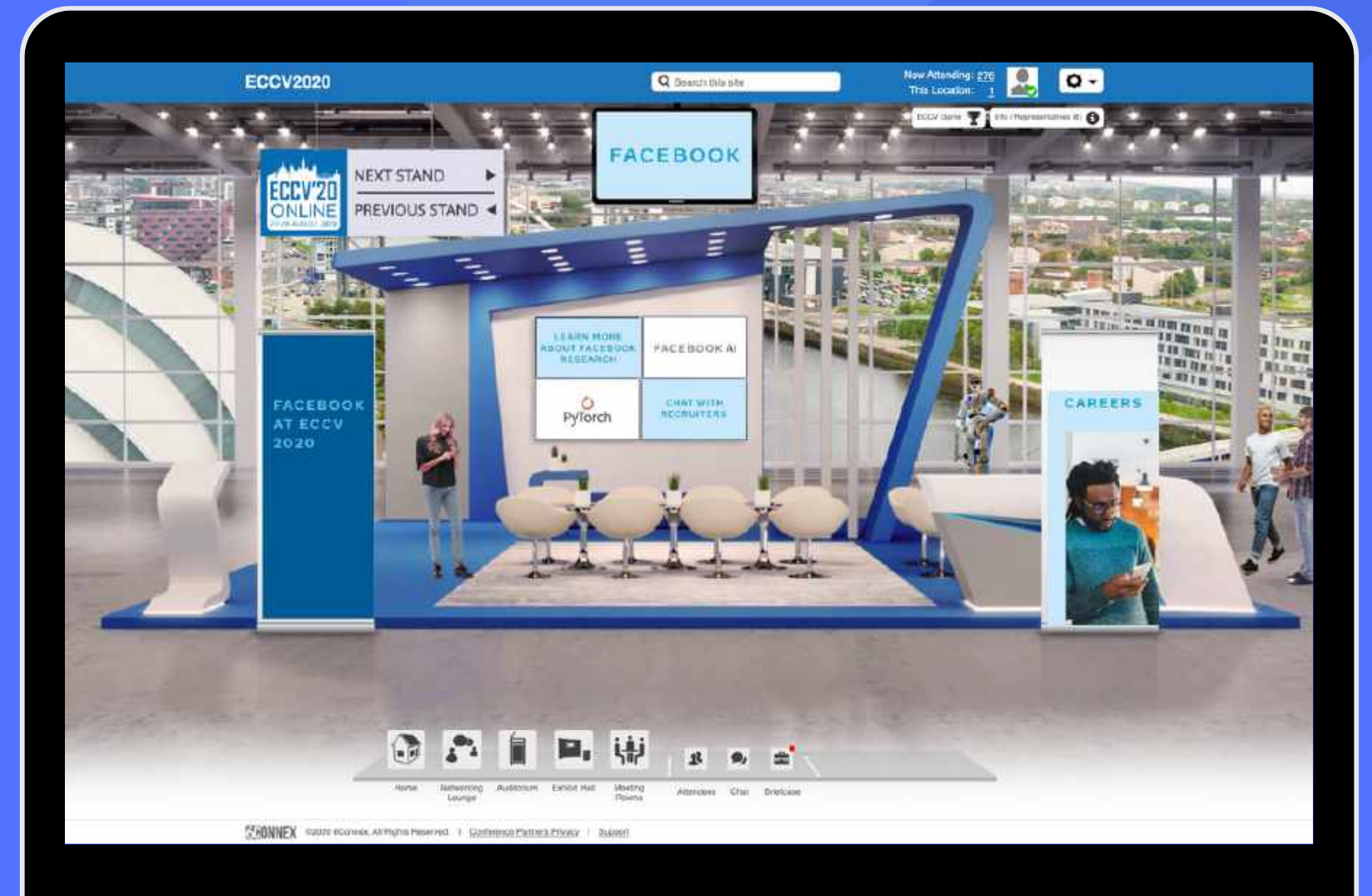
